REALIZE YOUR LONG-TERM EMPLOYMENT GOALS & INCREASE YOUR INDEPENDENCE THROUGH RCHA'S FAMILY SELF-SUFFICIENCY PROGRAM.

Program participants work with an experienced coordinator to establish their own employment goals and identify the necessary steps to reach those goals.

PROGRAM SUPPORT INCLUDES REFERRALS TO

- Child care
- Personal & career counseling
- Adult basic education
- College & technical education
- Job training
- Homeownership

As they make progress toward their goals, FSS participants may also benefit from contributions to an interest-bearing escrow account. When FSS participants complete the program, they receive the balance of the escrow account, which they can put toward education, transportation, or a down payment on a house.
